SITE INFORMATION

The test site is on state-owned property; there is a daily admission fee of \$10 (non-resident) and \$7 (resident) to be on the site. Permits can be purchased at the ranger station near the entrance to the park or ahead of time at most state parks and DNR offices. Please help us maintain access to this park for our tests by behaving as responsible dog fanciers, including cleaning up after your dog and respecting other park visitors. Dogs must be on leash at all times.

DRAWING FOR TRACK ORDER, Sunday, October 30, 2016

The draw for TD tracks will be held at 8:30 AM and 10:30 AM for TDX tracks. The test will begin as soon as practical after the draw. Bitches in season will be permitted to run and will be assigned to the last track.

LIMITATIONS ON ENTRIES

Entry is limited to AKC registered dogs at least six months of age or older. If the limit for entries is not reached in either the TD or TDX test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, tracks will be exchanged up to the judging limit of 8 tracks.

Entries must be made on an official American Kennel Club entry form, signed by the actual owner or duly authorized agent. Conditional, unsigned, telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. There will be a \$25.00 fee imposed for returned checks. All entries must be paid in full prior to showing. All TD entries must have a certification form attached.

Bitches in season may participate provided that the Test Secretary and Judges are notified that a bitch in season is present prior to the drawing for tracks. The last track shall be reserved for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held.

A worker draw will be held for this test in accordance with the Test Worker Option parameters set forth in Ch 1 Sec 13d of the Tracking Regulations and as determined by the club. The maximum allowable number of tracks will be set aside for workers at this test, provided entries at either level reach the minimum required (5). Preference in the draw will be given to dogs which have not previously earned a title at the level entered.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES

Entries will be acknowledged and a judging program will be mailed as stated in the regulations. Should you have any questions please contact the Test Secretary, Lorah Marquardt, bluestemK9@att.net Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee or because it has been entered incorrectly.

No video recording of this event will be allowed without prior permission of the Test Secretary and the judges.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE

From Interstate 39, take Highway 54 east towards Waupaca. After County Highway D, look for a brown State Park sign for the Park. Turn right on Hartman Creek Road. From Park entrance, continue straight to end of the road, turn left and go to first parking lot on left.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
