Classes with Jumps will be judged in **Jump Height order**, beginning with the **tallest** jump height then **descending**. Handlers with multiple entries in the same jump height will be accommodated.

A limited number of two-day Combination Obedience/Rally Catalogs will be available for purchase (\$10 each) at the trial. CATALOGS MAY BE ORDERED IN ADVANCE FOR \$5 EACH (see entry form).

Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations <u>must</u> be received in writing or via Email prior to the closing of entries, be legible, and include the AKC number of dog, or no refunds will be issued. No verbal changes accepted.

Move ups will be accepted as space permits within entry and judging time limits, in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. Requests for move ups must be made in writing and presented to the Event Secretary no less than 30 minutes before the start of each Trial.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Crating: Indoor crating for exhibitors will be available in a designated area only. No dogs may be left unattended. Neither TROCCW, Camp Bandy nor the Event Secretary will be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the site.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for maintaining clean conditions in and around their crates, pens, automobiles and throughout the grounds. Please pick up after your dogs. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial, with no entry fees refunded.

Ring Size: Ring size for Obedience and Rally will be 40 ft. x 50 ft. unless altered by the judge the day of trial.

Qualifying scores are required for all prizes in Regular Obedience and Rally Obedience Classes. All Special Prizes will be awarded and must be claimed by the conclusion of the Trial. None will be mailed. Winning dog and/or handler must be present or prize will be for feited. Any unclaimed award will remain with the TROCCW. If there are multiple entries of same dog, only the highest score will be eligible for special awards.

Definitions

HS Dog: dog of either sex with the Highest Qualifying Score in classes indicated.

HTQ Dog: dog of either sex with the Highest Combined Triple Qualifying Score in classes indicated.

Entry fees must be included with entry form. Make all Checks and Money Orders payable to the Timber Ridge Obedience Club of Central Wisconsin (TROCCW). The Event Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Entries without fees will not be accepted.

All overnight express mail entries must have the acceptance signature waived. Verbal, telephone, FAX, telegraph, and unsigned entries will not be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms or submitted without the AKC entry agreement will not be accepted.

Post-Dated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Event Secretary will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check.

No Refund For Duplicate Entries. Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entry Fees Will Not Be Refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, weather or other acts beyond the control of the Event Committee it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.

Refunds For Injured Dogs/Bitches In Season. Bitches in season will not be admitted to the Trial and are not permitted to compete. Entry fees for bitches in season or a dog injured after the trial closing date will be refunded (minus \$10.00/day administration fee) only if a veterinarian's excusal letter is presented to the Event Secretary 30 minutes prior to the start of judging on the trial date.

Errors On Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in the filling out of entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors, or for cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print carefully on entry forms to prevent errors.

Declination of Entries. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Timber Ridge Obedience Club of Central Wisconsin (TROCCW) may decline any entry and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against the TROCCW or any official thereof.

Exhibitors are Responsible for the Behavior of Their Dogs and/or Children. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise area. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. Dogs mayarrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

From East: Take Hwy 10 West toward Stevens Point. Exit on County Hwy B West (exit 238 from US- 10 W) toward Plover/Amherst. Turn right at the end of exit and follow County Hwy B West for approximately 0.1 miles. Take 1st left onto County Hwy Q follow for 1 mile, then left onto Main Street. Main Street becomes Lake Emily Drive. Camp Bandy is approximately 4 blocks on the right.
